## Linköping University

Linköping University (LiU), consists of four faculties and has app 27600 students. LiU started in the late 60's, and has been an innovator, creating new degree programs and new ways to tackle research problems. The Faculty of Health Sciences (FHS) is the medical faculty with a broad range of scientific activities ranging from basic biomedical and experimental clinical research to applied clinical research within the fields of nursing, physiotherapy, speech and language pathology, occupational therapy, medical pedagogy, and public health. The faculty also has a common Master program

The Speech and Language Pathology Program (SLP) is a four year education leading to a degree of Master in Speech and Language Pathology (four year). We have an annual intake of 40-42 students each fall. The prerequisites are: General requirements including at least a "passing degree" in *Swedish* and *English* from an upper secondary education and also *Mathematics B*, *Natural Sciences B* and *Social and Civic Sciences A*.

The major subject areas are speech and language pathology, linguistics and phonetics, psychology and medicine. The education consists of 15 courses. Specialties at LiU are interprofessional learning through common courses together with students from all educations at the Faculty of Health Sciences. The pedagogical model is problem based learning in small tutorial groups' through-out the education. Much effort has been devoted to bridging the gap between theory and practice in order to create high quality practical training and clinical rotations and, in the end, self sufficient SLPs.
