

Programme in Speech and Language Therapy (SLT) at University of Southern Denmark

University of Southern Denmark (SDU) consists of five faculties (Humanities, Science, Social Sciences, Health Sciences and Engineering), and it has about 20,000 students.

The Speech and Language Therapy programme at SDU was established in 2002 as a three years BA programme and in 2005 as a two years Master programme. The SLT BA and Master programmes are situated in the Institute of Language and Communication and are offered in a close collaboration between Faculty of Humanities and Faculty of Health.

Entry requirements for BA level are Danish (A level), English (B level), History (B level) and a second foreign language (A level). For the Master programme the entry requirements are a BA degree in SLT.

The BA programme comprises 180 ECTS, and the Master programme 120 ECTS. After obtaining the BA degree the graduate can work as an SLT.

The annual intake to the BA programme is 35-40 students and approximately 15 students to the Master programme.

The programme includes theoretical studies in logopedics, medicine, linguistics, psychology and pedagogy as well as studies in scientific research methods. A certain amount of practice is included in the programme (15 ECTS on BA as well as Master level).
