



Presentation of the University and the faculty:

The Complutense University of Madrid was founded in 1499 (Madrid). The UCM has about 83.000 students and 170 official courses. Speech and Language Therapy studies started in 1992. The Study Plan of the Degree of Speech and Language Therapy is adapted to the European Space for Higher Education, and offers 240 ECTS credits. The Faculty of Psychology is in charge of the degree, with the participation of the Faculties of Medicine, Education, and Philology.

Prerequisites to be able to study in the programme and the yearly intake:

In order to be eligible for the program, applicants will have to hold a high school degree in the modality of Sciences and Technology (Health Sciences) preferably. Applicants must also perform and access exam and to overcome the cut off score that will be set according to the number of applicants.

The content of the studies and the degree:

The degree of Speech and Language Therapy (SLT) is organized in modules and courses, and includes three professional trajectories:

M1 "Foundations / Basic topics (60 ECTS credits)": Human Autonomy (6), Physiology (6), Psychology (24), Statistics (12), Linguistics (12).

M2 "Alterations and disorders (36 ECTS credits)": Speech and Language Therapy, Science and Profession I (6), Treatment of Pathologies in clinical SLT (30).

M3 "Assessment and diagnosis (18 ECTS credits)": Assessment of language, communication, voice, and hearing (18).

M4 "SLT therapy (36 ECTS credits)": Speech and Language Therapy, Science and Profession II (6), Basic therapies in language and communication disorders (30).

M5 "Professional profile (54 ECTS credits)": Professional skills and resources (24), Professional trajectories (30 credits).

M6 "Additional training (18 credits)": Optional training complements (6 credits)

Module 7 "External Practice" (12 ECTS credits).

Other information:

Every academic year, the program will accept 120 new first year students.
