

## **Leeds Metropolitan University**

The **Faculty of Health and Social Sciences** is one of four faculties at Leeds Metropolitan University. The Faculty offers a wide portfolio of courses including nursing, physiotherapy, psychology, social work as well as speech and language therapy (SLT).

Students who complete the 3 year **BSc (Hons) Clinical Language Sciences (Speech and Language Therapy)** eligible to apply for HPC registration and practice as speech and language therapists. Our Course has an excellent reputation and always performs well in the National Student Survey.

### **Entry Requirements**

We accept A-levels (including Vocational), BTEC National Diploma, International Baccalaureate, and Irish Leaving Certificate: we require good grades (e.g. BBB at A-level). There are some restrictions as to the subjects, and we require a good set of GCSE's or equivalent to go with them. Foreign school-leaving qualifications we treat in a parallel fashion to this, subject to academic judgment. We also accept previous degrees and foundation degrees, and also suitable Access Diplomas, with good grades.

Applicants who have relevant experience are sometimes accepted with qualifications a little below what is normally required. The experience has to be substantial, and is normally a responsible job working with people: in the past this has been applied to Speech & Language Therapy Assistants, Teaching Assistants, and a manager in a private sector company. This type of solid experience can enable someone to make a great contribution to the course and the profession.

The Faculty also offers post qualifying courses for health professionals at MSc and doctoral level
