



ANADOLU UNIVERSITY

Anadolu University is one of the oldest and preeminent innovative state universities. It houses 12 faculties, 3 of which are distance education, 1 State Conservatory and 6 schools, 3 vocational schools, 5 graduate schools and 38 research centres and units. ECTS system for credit accumulation and transfer is used.

Currently, SLT can be studied at the postgraduate master and PhD level. Department of Speech and Language Therapy, affiliated to the Graduate School of Health Sciences, is located under the Education, Research and Training Centre for Speech and Language Pathology (DILKOM) which serves as a training program. The centre has fully equipped 5 major units to serve for advanced training (Phoniatrics, Stuttering, Aphasia, Developmental Language Disorders and Audiometry).

The prerequisites: Having an interdisciplinary relation with Bio-Medical Sciences, Linguistics, Psychology, Special Education, Child Development and Physical Therapy, this program requires candidates to be a bachelor's graduate of those relevant fields.

The yearly intake is 10 to 20 students. The applicants have to perform national access exams for graduate education (ALES) and English (UDS/KPSS).

The content of the studies and the degree is spread out over 7 to 8 semesters, requires to complete a year of Prerequisite Program embedded in the graduate degree. The courses include developmental language, articulation/phonology, SLI, aphasia and acquired disorders, fluency, swallowing, voice, counselling and clinical practicum (a minimum of 400 hours), evidence-based evaluation and treatment and a thesis or a project. The PhD Programme accepts students who have a master's degree.
