## 4. Abstract

These scientific sessions consist of presentations held by speech and language therapists and related professionals about their own professional experience, mainly directed to students and professionals, on a regular basis (monthly, 8 per academic year) for seven consecutive academic courses. Contents include use and results of assessment and intervention techniques, different work contexts, clinical cases on a variety of pathologies... They are organised in a 40-45 minutes oral exposition and a 20-30 minutes discussion. Theoretical aspects, if mentioned, are briefly exposed. Presentations are usually given with technological support (Power Point) and can be completed with videos, books, technical, or other audiovisual or written material. Sessions are free and open to interested audience, including all levels' speech and language therapy students.

Sessions try to show the variety of the professional practice and as a whole are not focused on any specific field of speech and language therapy. Topics included in the

last edition were: psychological problems affecting communication, speech therapist as essential resource for therapy process, multidisciplinary approach to neurological injury, facial paralysis in acquired cerebral injury, linguistic communicative skills in Asperger's syndrome, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, programme for improving oral and written expression and comprehension, and a case of developmental psychology from 0 to 12 months.

A variety of work contexts, assessment and intervention techniques, and pathologies is presented.

Attendants have the opportunity to learn from many different professionals and experiences, ask them about their usual work as speech therapists, and eventually familiarize about practical material.

They also can contact with former students from the same University who already show a professional development.

Issues which might not be included in the usual speech and language therapy programme can be addressed in these sessions.

Staff members can also attend the activity as part of their lifelong learning education.
